

The competition is open to all artists, aged 18 and over, who live or have studios within a 150-mile radius of Chicago. Work must have been created within the last three years. The competition accepts a broad spectrum of art media and styles.

JURORS

HEREACLITUS VERNON is a Chicago based performance, video, and visual artist that has presented their trans/disciplinary work throughout Europe and the US for 3 decades. They have a masters in Sculpture from Yale School of Art in 95'. As a result, they were awarded an ARTS RELIEF FUND from American Artists, a Robert Rauschenberg fund, and a grant from the Foundation for Contemporary Art. They have been recognized for their generous collaborations with the Chicago dance and performance community for 14 years. In March 2020 they contracted COVID 19 and to alchemize their harrowing near death experience, created a large public multi-window theatrical installation of mixed media to perform in. "At The Yellow Windows" was installed at Co-Prosperity Sphere and was made possible with a generous grant from the Andy Warhol Foundation. Hereaclitus Vernon's mixed media installation, FAE-RIETROPOLIS, was exhibited at the Bridgeport Art Center's 4th Floor Gallery in Environment/s/tallation January-March 2023.

MAGGIE LEDBETTER is an avid art collector and self-professed provocateur. She is the founder and Executive Director of the Underground Art Gallery Chicago (UAGC), a private arts institution in the Irving Park neighborhood, which she describes as "a stomping ground for creatives of all types, one -part swanky clubhouse, one part subversive charity." The missions of the UAGC are to put money in the hands of artists; to encourage creative collaboration and interdisciplinary community-building; and to make fine art more accessible to the masses. When Maggie isn't hustling for the UAGC, she applies her law degree to investigating criminal cases, and (ostensibly) "solves murder mysteries with math" using a heuristic she calls "Double Tunnel Vision." She is currently writing a book on the subject, entitled Doubt, coming out in 2024.






